

2009 TULSA NATIONALS / TEAM OVERTIME REGISTRATION

The **TEAM OVERTIME** registration will be sent by FedEx on December 31, 2008. Therefore all wrestlers must submit their registration form and entry fee to Overtime NO LATER THAN TUESDAY, DECEMBER 30, 2008. This will give each wrestler some time to decide on a weight class and ensure our registration process is on time. **TEAM ENTRY IS IMPORTANT FOR TEAM POINTS AND BRACKET SEPARATION OF WRESTLERS AT THE SAME AGE/WEIGHT.**

Hotel and Travel: All wrestlers and parents are responsible for their own travel and hotel arrangements. Parents and wrestlers are encouraged to make hotel accommodations the (Host Hotel) Doubletree at Warren Place 918-495-1000 (\$99/night). The Overtime staff will be staying at the Doubletree as well. Please note: rooms go fast, so it is best to make reservations well in advance.

Tournament Entry Fee: \$45.00 (Please make this payable to OVERTIME as one team entry fee will be submitted.)

Weigh-ins: Individual wrestlers and their parents are responsible for making weight and completing the official weigh-in procedures required for the tournament.

Singlets: TEAM OVERTIME folkstyle singlets will be available for use at all of the National Tournaments; however, they are not for sale. Singlets will be issued on the last day of training camp and each wrestler is responsible for that singlet until the completion of the tournament at which time they are to be turned back in to Sean. If a singlet is lost, stolen or damaged, a charge of \$100.00 will be due for replacement of the item.

Coaching: Wrestling is tentatively scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, January 16th after the opening ceremonies. Overtime Staff will be present at all sessions and plan to monitor and coach as many OVERTIME wrestlers as possible. However, parents should be prepared to step in for coaching if we are occupied with wrestlers at any given time. It is important to keep in mind that only one individual at a time should be giving advice and instruction to a wrestler from the coach's corner. For example, if I am in a wrestler's corner I expect to give instruction and direction while parents provide support, not coaching, from the side. Parents: if you feel that your child is more comfortable with and will perform better under your coaching direction, please let me know and I will gladly monitor his matches and progress only. Too many voices giving instruction and coaching at the same time can be very confusing to a wrestler out on the mat, and I would like to avoid this.

Coaching passes: I will pick up and purchase as many coaching passes as the team entries permit for distribution at the weigh-ins. Passes may have to be shared. Coaching passes are \$40.00

Arena Seating: OVERTIME wrestlers and parents are encouraged to sit together during the competition. This will make locating parents and wrestlers much easier throughout the event and provides unity amongst team members.

Warm-up: Prior to the start of competition each day, every wrestler's warm-up is essential to a good performance. However, at most of these National Tournaments it is very difficult to find adequate warm-up conditions and mat space. Given this it is very important that all OVERTIME wrestlers meet in the designated seating area with plenty of time prior to the start of the competition each day for warm-up instruction and supervision.

Parent Notice: To avoid any athlete registration errors, your completed individual Team Overtime form will be submitted for tournament entry. There will be no exceptions! No wrestler will be registered with TEAM OVERTIME without submitting their registration form by the due date. The team registration form must be completed in full with the wrestler's correct age & weight category, along with any seeding information you feel is appropriate (*current record, state, and national accomplishments.*)

The Team Overtime individual registration form must be accurately completed and returned with the \$45.00 entry fee by DECEMBER 30, 2008. To avoid errors, no phone-in or other registration options will be permitted through Overtime.

Please pay and enter as a team to be considered for team competition.

PLACE:Expo Square Pavilion, 1701 S. Louisville (Tulsa Fairgrounds), Tulsa, Oklahoma

RULES: Modified National Federation High School Rules (minimum rest between matches and maximum number of matches in a day not in effect). Hair code & fingernails will be enforced by referees. Hair cover (if required) must be with wrestler at weigh-in. Head gear required for 15 & under age group.

ENTRY DEADLINE: 9:00 PM Saturday, January 3, 2009. Entries must be RECEIVED by 1-3-2009. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION NO LATE ENTRIES, PRE-PAY AND PRE-ENTER. MUST MAKE WEIGHT ENTERED. NO CHANGES AT WEIGH-IN. LIMITED TO THE FIRST 3000 ENTRIES.

FEE: Pre-entry of \$45.00 payable to TULSA NATIONALS to be paid by 9:00 PM, Saturday, January 3, 2009. Wrestler may enter only one weight class and only one age group. NO MOVING. Tulsa Nationals entry forms must be used for entries. **Please pay and enter as a team to be considered for team competition.** No refunds!

FORMAT: Collegiate style. Double Elimination – Challenge for second format. Referee decisions final. All protests to be directed to tournament directors along with a \$35 protest fee. All age protests must be made before final match Friday night. Birth certificates must be available. No cameras allowed on floor!

WEIGH-INS: Thursday, January 15, 2009, 4:00 PM till 6:00 PM at Expo Square Pavilion for 6, 8, and 10 and under age groups only. No 12 or 15 and Under! The 12 and 15 and under age group will weigh in on Friday, January 16th, from 12:00 - 2:00 PM in Exchange Center. STATE ISSUED BIRTH CERTIFICATES REQUIRED IF REQUESTED BY TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS. NO HOSPITAL CERTIFICATES ACCEPTED. WEIGH IN BY WEIGHTS per age group.

Must make weight in competition singlet. Hair cover (if required) must be with wrestler at weigh-in.

TIME PERIODS: 6 and 8 & under 1-1-1 including finals. 10, 12, and 15 & under 1 1/2 - 1 1/2 - 1 1/2 including finals. Consolations matches 1-1-1. Overtime – NFHS rules.

SEEDING: Wednesday, January 7, 2009, at 7:00 PM at Doubletree @ Warren Place, 6110 S. Yale. Coaches indicate boys records who need to be seeded. Coaches only at seeding meeting.

AWARDS: Medals 1st through 6th. Special Awards for 1st through 3rd. Outstanding Wrestler Trophy in EACH age group based on champion with most falls (including technical falls) in least amount of time. Team Trophy in each age group. Team with most points based on point system 14-10-7-4-2-1 is champion. If tied, next criteria is most champions. Must wrestle for your own team. Teams to be considered for team competition must submit all wrestlers names on one entry form. Must be present to win. All Star Teams cannot compete for team awards. Second leg of Trinity Award and a qualifier for World All Star Team.
